IACP New Membership Plan Summary

Individual Plan | Dues: \$195/person

Benefits:

- Access to Members Section of website, including networking, educational, public education, and marketing content, and professional tools such as model participation agreements, practice group protocols, and assessment tools.
- All IACP communications (emails, newsletters, etc.)
- Collaborative Review issues
- Full member public profile with hotlink to member's website *included*
- Forum and Institute discount
- Permitted Use of "C" mark and other IACP promotional materials
- Free Webinars and other educational opportunities as offered

Emeritus Membership | Dues: \$75/person

Requirements

• Former member of IACP, no longer practicing, over age 65

Benefits

• All benefits of Individual Membership. *The public profile of Emeritus Members will indicate that they are no longer practicing.*

Student Membership | Dues: \$75/person

Requirements

• Current registration in an educational program that will lead to entitlement to practice as a professional in one of the CP fields

Benefits

• All benefits of Individual Membership. The public profile of Student Members will indicate that they are currently a student in training.

Whole Group Membership | Dues: \$145/person

Requirements

- Membership in a Practice Group that requires IACP membership for all its members.
- Practice Group must certify its Whole Group status and membership annually.

Benefits

All benefits of Individual Membership.

Global Partners Organizational Membership Dues: \$800/organization

Requirements

- Available to nonprofits/NGOs and practice groups that support IACP's mission
- Commitment to work together with other Global Partners to promote the availability of CP around the globe
- Commitment to creating alliances and maintaining a strong reciprocal working relationship with IACP
- Mutual agreement to post each other's logo and hotlink on organization's website, and to distribute each other's conference and meeting announcements through regular channels

Benefits

- Organization is listed with other Global Partners on IACP's website and printed materials
- Logo/hotlink to Global Partner's website on IACP's site (reciprocal linkage)
- Distribution of Global Partner conference announcements through IACP (reciprocal announcements)
- Special Gathering at Forum for Global Partner representatives with IACP Board and ED
- Invitation to quarterly Global Partner planning conference calls with IACP President and ED
- Organization is permitted use of "C" mark and other IACP promotional materials
 Organization dues Include individual membership for one Global Partner representative, and \$100 discount off Member rates to Forum and Institute for one representative at each meeting.

IACP NEW Membership Plan FAQs

Joining IACP

I noticed that dues are increasing. Why is that?

IACP hasn't increased dues in over five years, and membership dues, along with Forum registration, represent the vast majority of our budget. We are an organization that is supported by its members. We need to raise dues to keep up with inflation, and to enable us to provide valuable services to members while meeting our mission of supporting the growth of CP around the world. We are also now offering discounted membership for retired members, and for students.

When will this new membership plan start?

It will start when we debut our upgraded website. Until then, if it is time to pay your annual membership dues, you can renew under the old system at the old rates and your renewed membership will be valid for the coming year. We will announce a date for the new website debut as soon as we are able.

What happened to the hot link charge?

A hot link to your website, which used to require an extra fee, is now included free as a benefit of membership!

What is Whole Group membership?

Many Collaborative Practice groups have made the choice to require all their members to be members of IACP. When groups elect Whole Group status, their members benefit from being included in the worldwide community of Collaborative professionals. Whole Group members are entitled to a discount on their IACP membership and pay the reduced \$145 Whole Group Membership fee. For more information about Whole Group membership, please speak to your Practice Group leader.

How do I know if I am eligible for Whole Group membership?

You are eligible for whole group membership if you are a member of a practice group that has committed to requiring IACP membership for all of its members. Once the new website is up, if your practice group is listed with IACP as a Whole Group, and if they have confirmed your membership in the practice group (reconfirmed annually), then you will be able to access the Whole Group rate on the website. For now, if you are not sure whether your practice group provides access to Whole Group membership, ask your Practice Group leader, or contact IACP.

How can my practice group become a Whole Group?

What is Global Partner Membership?

Global Partners are organizations that want to make an extra commitment to work collectively to leverage resources, spread the word, and find ways to make CP available around the globe. Global Partners can be organizations in areas of the world where CP is just getting started, who want to find more ways to connect with the worldwide CP community. They can also be organizations in areas

where CP is more established, who want to increase their partnership with organizations around the world, and share knowledge and resources.

Can a group be both a Whole Group and a Global Partner?

Yes, if a Whole Group wants to participate more actively in working together with allies around the globe to expand the availability of CP, it is welcome to also become a Global Partner!
